Workshop Descriptions:

1. Creative Discovery Workshops

Students go through a guided discovery workshop where they explore tools of choreography. The workshop has a short theoretical component outlining basic choreographic concepts such as space, time, shape and content. The main part of the workshop leads the students to discover their own original movement through a series of exploratory choreographic exercises.

2. Contemporary Dance Technique Workshop

Contemporary dance class taught from beginner dancers through to advanced students. Class is created fusing elements of ballet, hip-hop and classical modern dance.
